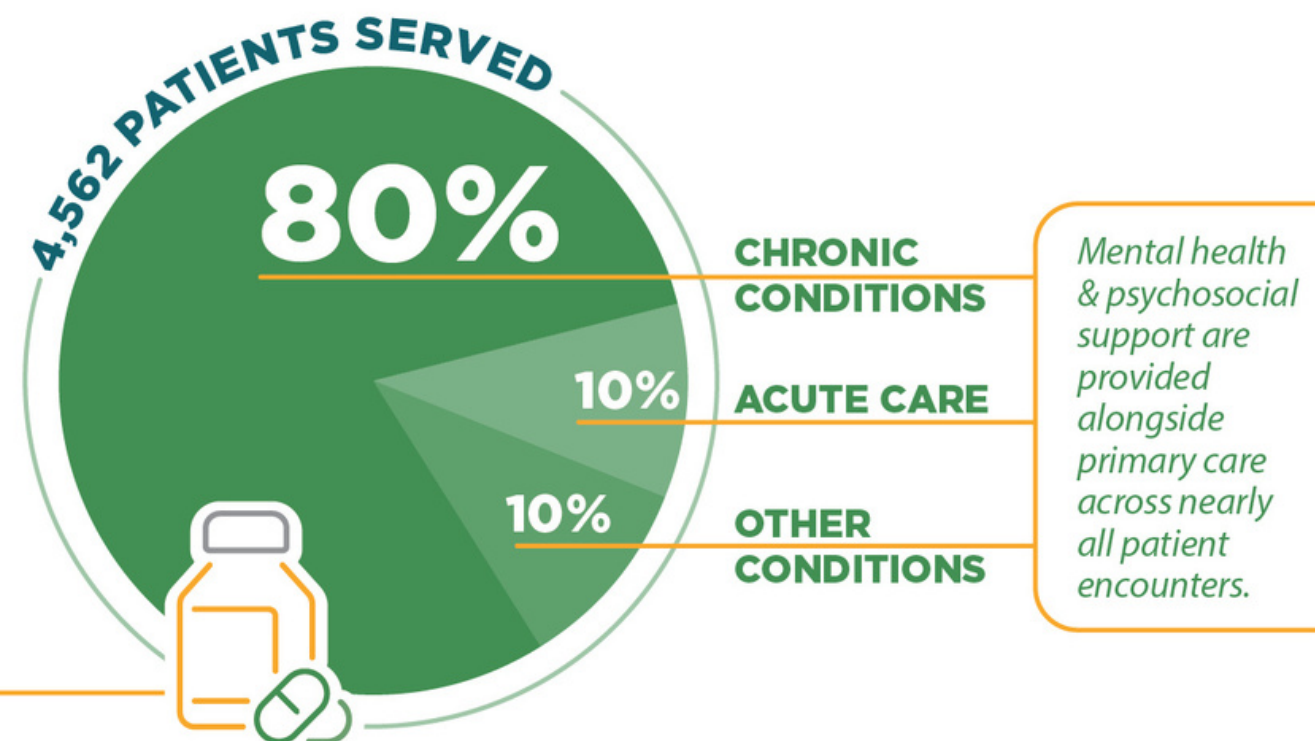
Continuity in Practice

GCF focuses on routine and ongoing treatment, the type of care most often lost in crisis.

Most patients manage conditions such as heart disease, diabetes, asthma, and hypertension, all of which require consistent care, not one time intervention.

Returning to the same communities helps stabilize patient health over time which dramatically improves outcomes.

*GCF provided **over \$87,000** in medications, with nearly 90% supporting chronic disease management.*



Coordinated for Greater Impact

Supported by in country field teams, Global Care Force operates with a strong local presence, ensuring care is aligned with real time needs.

Working within established humanitarian systems, GCF partners with organizations such as WHO health clusters, the Danish Red Cross, and local and regional authorities to deliver coordinated care.

Field Leadership Spotlight

Dr. Lev Prystupiyuk, Chief Medical Director, Ukraine



Dr. Prystupiyuk leads operations in Ukraine, he coordinates outreach across rural and high need areas while working with partners and local government to reach communities where access to care has been disrupted.

His leadership connects deployments to local systems and sustains care beyond individual missions. In 2025, he was awarded a commendation by Ukraine's Ministry of Defense for his service in deoccupied territories.

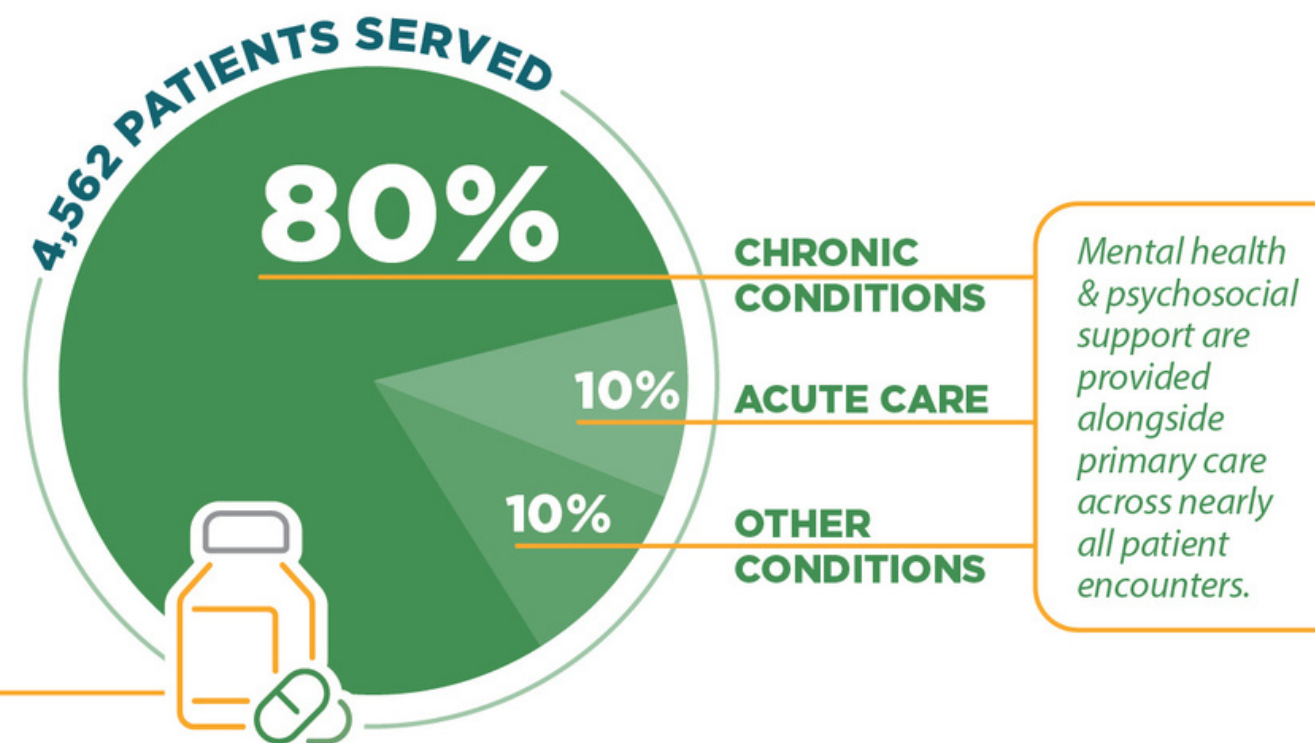
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Focused Presence. Broader Vision.

In 2025, Global Care Force continued to build on a model centered on continuity of care, returning to the same communities and strengthening access where it is often disrupted, with ongoing work in Ukraine and the Middle East, and targeted assessments in Uganda and India.

The need for consistent, reliable healthcare remains urgent.

In the year ahead, we will continue monthly deployments in Ukraine, expand team capacity, and strengthen follow up care and referral pathways. We will also deepen partnerships that support more integrated and coordinated models of care, further connect our work within local systems, and continue exploring opportunities to responsibly expand our programming into regions where many communities still lack reliable healthcare services.

Our focus remains clear: expanding access to care, strengthening what exists, and improving outcomes over time.
