Saving Lives Through Compassionate Care


As life's tides ebb and flow, Global Care Force volunteers are there for people at their lowest, a wave rolling in to lift them up.

In 2024, volunteers delivered compassionate care across four continents. In Ukraine, ongoing war makes the monthly return of volunteers and free medications a vital lifeline.

In Egypt, a humanitarian crisis leaves millions, including refugees displaced by conflict, with health care needs unmet.

In the U.S., volunteers cared for migrants, asylum seekers and individuals experiencing homelessness with empathy and kindness in El Paso, Texas, and Gallup, New Mexico. Through serving, volunteers are transformed as they remind those they help that they matter and are not forgotten.
